

Jointer

To certify on the jointer you will need to know:

1. The safety rules.
2. The parts of the jointer.
3. How to determine the correct grain direction.
4. Operation of the jointer.

Jointer safety rules.

1. Wear eye protection
2. Wood should be at least 12" in length.
3. Use a push stick when the wood is below the top of the fence.
4. Check to see that there is no metal, loose knots or other foreign materials. (These might fly when the cutting blade comes in contact with them.)
5. An assistant should help support long pieces.
6. The guard should be in place at all times.
7. Turn off the jointer and wait for the blade to stop before leaving.
8. Check with the instructor before you adjust the tables.
